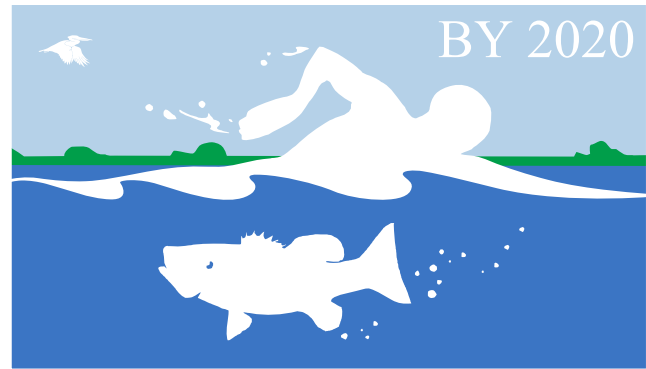

Fishable Swimmable by 2020:

What Can I Do?



1) Reduce excess fertilizer on your lawn

- Save money and reduce algae in the river.



2) Keep your shore green and natural

- Wetlands and trees are not only beautiful - they filter pollution and harbor wildlife.



3) Only rain down the drain

- Stormwater is the top carrier of river pollution.



4) Leave your car at home

- Pollution in the air falls into the water to cause up to 30% of excess river nutrients.



5) Scoop the poop

- Dogs are one reason we can't swim in the river.



6) Grow oysters for restoration

- One oyster filters up to 60 gallons of river water a day.



7) Install a rain barrel

- Reuse your stormwater - save money and reduce runoff.



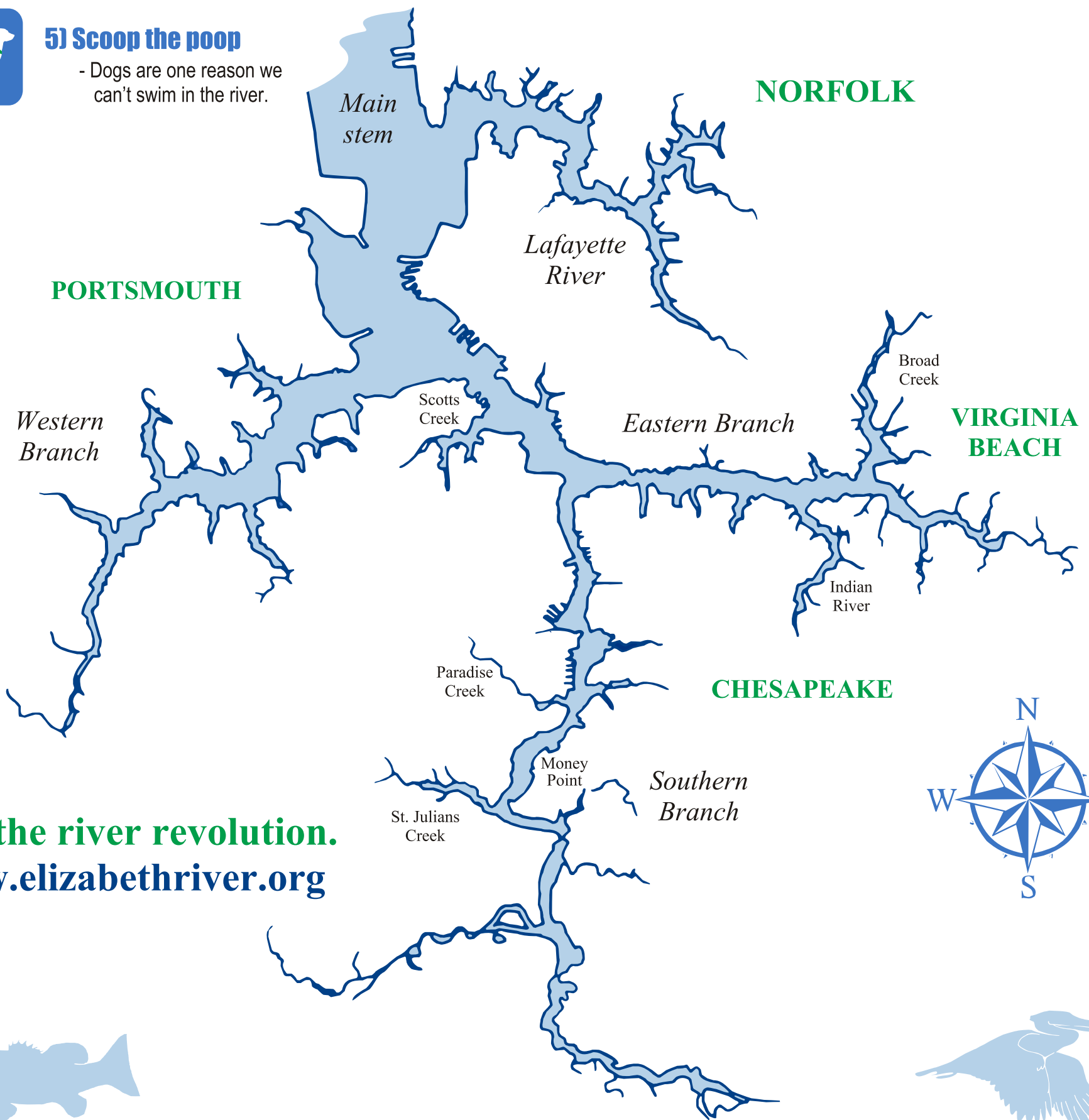
8) Switch to reusable bags
